The Committee on Homeland Security met, pursuant to notice, in open markup session, a quorum being present, on Wednesday, January 20, 2010, in 311 Cannon House Office Building to consider H. Res. 980. The Committee took the following actions:

H. Res. 980, Of inquiry directing the Secretary of Homeland Security to transmit to the House of Representatives a copy of the Transportation Security Administration's Aviation Security Screening Management Standard Operating Procedures manual in effect on December 5, 2009, and any subsequent revisions of such manual in effect prior to the adoption of this resolution; was ordered to be adversely reported to the House by a recorded vote of 24 yeas and 0 nays.
